BNY Mellon Announces Gift of Art to PAMM's Permanent Collection

MIAMI – September 30, 2015 – At the Eighth Annual Pérez Art Museum Miami (PAMM) Corporate Luncheon, presented by South Motors Automotive Group and STARR Events, South Florida's business community gathered to honor the legacy of R. Kirk Landon with PAMM Corporate Honors. Landon benefitted a long list of South Florida's nonprofit organizations, including schools, universities and arts groups, and was deeply passionate about education.

"R. Kirk Landon left an indelible mark on the institutions and people he touched through his generosity, including PAMM," said PAMM board of trustees Chairman Aaron Podhurst. "We are pleased to donate all funds from the Luncheon to the museum's education program as a memorial gift in his name."

In the spirit of corporate philanthropy, BNY Mellon announced a gift of art to the museum's permanent collection. The painting, Mel Bochner's *Dead Reckoning*, was on view nearly 30 years ago at the Center for Fine Arts, PAMM's predecessor, during the travelling exhibition *Mel Bochner: 1973-1985*. In addition to the gift, BNY Mellon is sponsoring several exhibitions at the museum, including *Project Gallery: Nicolas Lobo* and *Project Gallery: Bik Van der Pol*, on view now, and *Firelei Báez: Bloodlines*, which opens on October 15, 2015.

"Miami is fortunate to be home to many successful businesses and professionals who care about the community they operate in," said Luncheon Co-Chair Jorge M. Pérez. "This museum, and Miami's cultural landscape, is growing and thriving because of the businesses that provide support in the arts, like BNY Mellon."

More than 250 of South Florida's most influential business leaders attended the highly-anticipated luncheon, which honors the corporate community for its vital support of the arts in South Florida.
