Teen Arts Council 2026-27

Pérez Art Museum Miami (PAMM) is accepting applications from rising freshmen, sophomores, juniors, and seniors (2026-2027 school year) for the PAMM Teen Arts Council (PTAC). Members will help fulfill the museum’s mission to improve the quality of life in Miami-Dade County through education and interaction with the art of today. Through mentorship, ambassadorship, and advocacy, teen members will visit cultural organizations, attend professional development workshops (art-making, public speaking, resume building, etc.), meet and interview artists, plan three public events for PAMM, develop their own touring practice, and so much more.

After completing an application, selected nominees will interview for council positions. Up to eight high school students will be selected for the council. Members begin their council position in October with weekly Thursday meetings and remain active until the end of the school year (June 2027). PTAC membership may be renewed based on performance during the previous year. If accepted, transportation is covered. Program instruction will take place primarily in English.

PTAC Requirements

To apply for PTAC, candidates must meet these requirements:

1. Grade- Be a 9th, 10th, 11th, or 12th grader during the 2026-2027 school year.
2. Submit a completed application by **August 31, 2026**
3. Interests- Teens interested in art, music, culture, museums and all types of creative outlets are welcome! You do not need to be an artist in order to apply.
4. Availability- PTAC meets every Thursday from 4:00 - 6:30pm. Occasional Saturdays and event days are required beyond regular meeting times. PAMM takes all school calendars and transportation into consideration when scheduling programming.
5. PTAC members are expected to follow the rules and guidelines of the program, participate in weekly meetings and occasional events, fulfill solo and group responsibilities such as art assignments, independent research, inquiry and tour review, and develop teen centered events for the museum.
